

Student Trip Policies and Procedures Reno, Jazz A, B, and C, April 22-25, 2010

It is understood that all Moorpark High School rules shall be followed while on the trip to **Reno, NV. with the Moorpark High School Jazz Bands, April 22-25, 2010.** It is also understood that behavior that is disruptive or/and disrespectful and interferes with the trip will be severely dealt with by the faculty present on the trip.

CONSEQUENCES: A student will be sent home at the parent/guardian's expense in the event that he/she breaks any of the rules, acts inappropriately, or becomes severely ill. Behavior on past trips, and in ALL classes during the year will dictate the level of leniency for any indiscretion on the part of a student.

This Behavior Contract is for Jazz Band Member:

CONDUCT

1. I understand that I am representing my school, my community, and my family and will behave and dress appropriately AT ALL TIMES while on this trip. While at the Reno Jazz festival, I will proudly wear my school jazz shirt at all times when not performing.
2. My behavior will be subdued and courteous in public establishments such as hotel lobby/halls, restaurants, the festival, etc.
3. I will be courteous and respectful of everyone on the trip including other hotel guests, bus drivers, chaperones, and band students.
4. I will represent my community, school, and band with my best conduct, attitude, and effort.
5. I will keep my itinerary close at hand, and never be late to a meeting time/place.
6. I will never leave the premises of the hotel, or the premises of the jazz festival while we are at either.
7. I will be present and supportive at the performances of all Moorpark High School bands, even when I am not performing.

HOTEL BEHAVIOR

1. I understand there will be NO boys in girls' rooms and NO girls in boys' rooms.
2. When I am told to be in my room, I will be there and not leave.
3. When it is curfew, lights will go out, and I will go to sleep.
4. I will respect my room mates' belongings and their space.
5. I will respect hotel property and help to keep it clean. I will not create any extra work for any hotel staff member.
6. The directors reserve the right to rearrange any rooming assignments at any time, as needed.

ILLNESS: Any illness or injury should be reported to your chaperone and Director immediately no matter how unimportant it may seem. In the event that a student becomes too ill to continue to participate, the student may be sent home *at the parent's expense.*

ELECTRONICS/MISC.: Students may bring small electronics such as ipods, etc. at their own risk. If any item is stolen or lost, it is the owner's responsibility. The trip will not be held up in any way, nor will the school, or band director be held liable for the replacement of these items.
